1. Students meeting along with their Parents should be arranged on regular basis.

A Local Guardian (LG) would be allocated for 15 students. The concerned LG will call the parents of the students whose class attendance / performance is not up to the mark to meet the concerned faculty, HoDs / Principal depending on the severity of the issue if any. We are in the direction to conduct a meeting of all the parents once in a semester.

2. Performance and any other activities of the students should be informed to their parents.

We are communicating regarding this on regular basis and even we are calling the parents to meet the respective class co-ordinators and the concerned staff handling the subjects as

necessary.

3. A committee should be formed to assess the faculty performance.

Student feedback is being taken and evaluated every semester. Necessary guidance / inputs are being given to the faculty as desirable by the respective HoDs and the Principal. A committee comprising the senior faculty would be formed department wise to make it still more productive.

4. Reward the students whose performance is consistent and good. The poor performing students should be identified and suitable measures should be taken.

We are encouraging the students with good track of performance in getting the merit scholarships and further this would be considered to award even from the Institution end subject to the approval of the management.

As specified above, each faculty would be assigned with 15 students to take care the personal and performance aspects. The students shall meet the allocated faculty and report their problems if any. The concerned faculty in turn resolves the issues if any with the guidance of senior faculty / HoD / Principal as necessary.

5. Students should be encouraged by sending them for industrial visits and related educational fairs / exhibitions.

In this regard, we are sending the students to present their project work / technical papers in the exhibitions / competitions / workshops / conferences with partial financial assistance. Further, we are sending the students for the industrial visits / educational tours to reinforce the theoretical and practical knowledge.

6. Publicize regarding the placements so as to reach the public and the parents.

We are updating placement activities in the college website. Further, we broadcast the same

along with the various institutional activities through the print and electronic media.

7. Assignments should be given to the students to enhance the results.

Assignments are being given on the regular basis as suggested by the Hon'ble council. Further, as per the University curriculum of the revised syllabus, assignments are made mandate and they are evaluated for the award of 10 Marks in each subject of the Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE).

8. The academic results should be improved further through effective measures.

The results are being considerably improved when compared to the previous semester results. We are trying our best to improve the results further by conducting special classes and counseling the students whose performance is not up to the mark.

9. Expansion of the Girls hostel is suggested to be initiated to accommodate more number of students.

The concerned LG will call the parents of the students whose class attendance / performance is not up to the mark to meet the concerned faculty, HoDs / Principal depending on the severity of the issue if any. We are in the direction to conduct a meeting of all the parents once in a semester.
- 2. Performance and any other activities of the students should be informed to their parents. We are communicating regarding this on regular basis and even we are calling the parents to meet the respective class co-ordinators and the concerned staff handling the subjects as necessary.
- 3. A committee should be formed to assess the faculty performance. Student feedback is being taken and evaluated every semester. Necessary guidance / inputs are being given to the faculty as desirable by the respective HoDs and the Principal. A committee comprising the senior faculty would be formed department wise to make it still more productive.
- 4. Reward the students whose performance is consistent and good. The poor performing students should be identified and suitable measures should be taken.
 - We are encouraging the students with good track of performance in getting the merit scholarships and further this would be considered to award even from the Institution end subject to the approval of the management.
 - As specified above, each faculty would be assigned with 15 students to take care the personal and performance aspects. The students shall meet the allocated faculty and report their problems if any. The concerned faculty in turn resolves the issues if any with the guidance of senior faculty / HoD / Principal as necessary.
- 5. Students should be encouraged by sending them for industrial visits and related educational fairs / exhibitions.
 - In this regard, we are sending the students to present their project work / technical papers in the exhibitions / competitions / workshops / conferences with partial financial a stance Further, we are

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sending the students for the industrial visits / educational tours to reinforce the theoretical and practical knowledge.

6. Publicize regarding the placements so as to reach the public and the parents.

We are updating placement activities in the college website. Further, we broadcast the same along with the various institutional activities through the print and electronic media.

7. Assignments should be given to the students to enhance the results.

Assignments are being given on the regular basis as suggested by the Hon'ble council. Further, as per the University curriculum of the revised syllabus, assignments are made mandate and they are evaluated for the award of 10 Marks in each subject of the Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE).
