

The SDUET offers education from kindergarten to post-doctoral levels. An outspoken politician, Jalappa was a member of the Indian National Congress. He also led the cooperative movement, promoting agricultural, horticultural, and dairy farming. In 2001, he founded the R. L. Jalappa Institute of Technology (RLJIT) in Doddaballapur, affiliated with Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belagavi. His contributions to education and social welfare remain significant.
