R. L. Jalappa was a visionary educationist, politician, and social worker who founded the Sri Devaraj Urs Educational Trust (SDUET) in 1986 to support the people of Kolar, particularly those from backward classes. The SDUET offers education from kindergarten to post-doctoral levels. An outspoken politician, Jalappa was a member of the Indian National Congress. He also led the cooperative movement, promoting agricultural, horticultural, and dairy farming. In 2001, he founded the R. L. Jalappa Institute of Technology (RLJIT) in Doddaballapur, affiliated with Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belagavi. His contributions to education and social welfare remain significant.

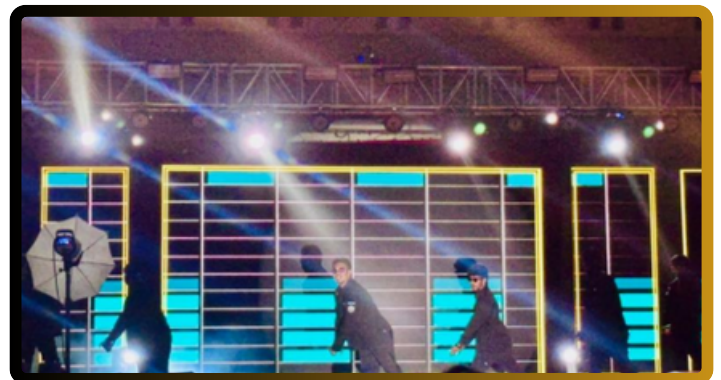
FRESHER'S DAY

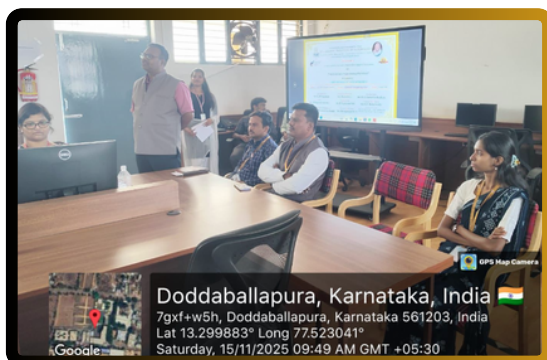

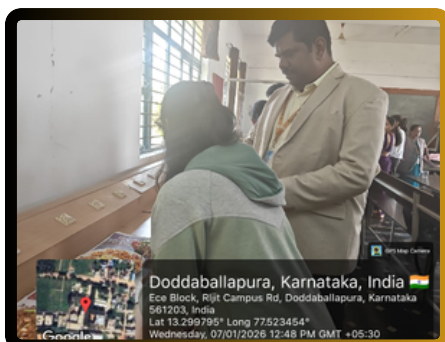
Children's Day
